

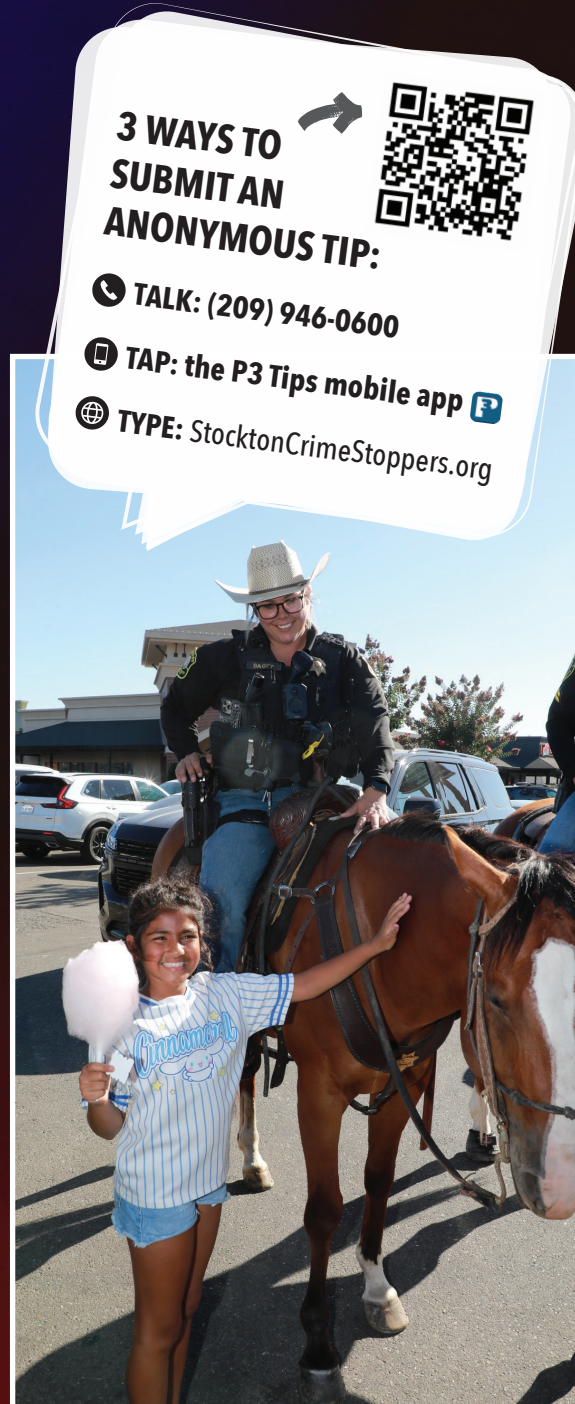
The Process

- 1 Submit a Tip** – Provide anonymous information about a crime, suspect, or fugitive.
- 2 Tip Assigned** – Your tip is given a confidential ID number and sent to law enforcement to investigate.
- 3 Case Review** – If the information results in an arrest, your tip number is submitted for reward approval.
- 4 Collect Reward** – A cash reward is paid using the assigned tip number.

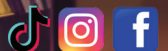

Frequently Asked Questions

Will Crime Stoppers ask for my personal information?

No. We will never ask for your name, phone number, address, or anything that could identify you.

Are calls recorded?

No. We do not record calls or use caller ID. No one will know you contacted us unless you tell them.

How am I identified?

When you submit a tip, you'll receive a code number. This code is the only way we can track your tip—so keep it safe.

Can Crime Stoppers call me with an update?

No. Since we don't ask for your phone number, you must call us back with your code number to check your tip's status.

How do I receive a reward?

If your tip leads to an arrest, we'll give you instructions to collect a cash reward at a designated location. No ID is required, and the money does not need to be reported.

Where should I submit my tip?

You must report directly to the Stockton Crime Stoppers Tip Line, through the P3 Tips Mobile App, or the Stockton Crime Stoppers website.
